



Governor Allowance Policy

This Policy Statement has been developed in accordance with the Education (Governors' Allowances) Regulations 2003. These Regulations give Governing Bodies the discretion to pay, or not to pay, allowances from the school's annual budget allocation to governors (or co-opted non-Governors) for certain expenditure which they incur in carrying out their duties.

Oakhurst Community Primary School Governing Body has reviewed the Governors' Allowances Regulations and agrees the following:

1. Governors shall not be paid attendance allowance;
2. Governors shall not be reimbursed for loss of earnings;
3. Governors are entitled to claim reasonable expenses, such as travel to training outside of Swindon and childcare costs, subject to prior approval and subject to budget availability;
4. Governors shall be able to use the school office printing and photocopying facilities in the course of carrying out their duties, permission to such request not unreasonably being refused.

If this policy is deemed at any time to be detrimental to any current or potential Governor, this policy will be reviewed immediately.
